A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Collin Scanlan; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Collin Scanlan has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank
3 conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and Collin
8 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught
9 through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 827 and has demonstrated
11 great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America
12 program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, a senior at North Gwinnett High School, Collin is a member of the varsity
14 lacrosse team, serves as a freshman mentor, is a certified lifeguard, and works every summer
15 as a counselor for the YMCA Camp High Harbour at the Rabun Gap Nacoochee School; and
- 16 WHEREAS, to earn the rank of Eagle Scout, Collin collected over 1,000 food items for the
17 North Gwinnett Food Co-op; and
- 18 WHEREAS, during his years in the Boy Scouts of America program, Collin has been elected
19 to serve several terms as Patrol Leader, attended two high adventure camp outs, and was
20 elected Crew Leader during his troop's trip to the Philmont Scout Camp in New Mexico; and

21 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Collin has truly exhibited a commitment to the
22 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
23 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

24 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
25 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
27 commend Collin Scanlan for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor
28 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious
29 rank of Eagle Scout.
