## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Georgia's Legacy; Older Women! (GLOW) and 2010 GLOW honoree Carol

3 WHEREAS, Georgia's Legacy; Older Women! is an organization which recognizes the many  
4 contributions of women who are past the usual age of retirement but who remain actively  
5 engaged in business, employment, or volunteering; and

6 WHEREAS, this organization and its incredible members promote community service and  
7 encourage women to make a difference in the areas of the arts, education, women's health  
8 issues, finance, and safety issues concerning children and senior citizens; and

9 WHEREAS, the organization also encourages its members to address global relations and  
10 international affairs and to assist other women in becoming economic and business leaders

16 WHEREAS, Carol Hunstein serves as Chief Justice of the Georgia Supreme Court and has  
17 been recognized with numerous honors and accolades, including the Leadership Award from  
18 the Georgia Women's Institute and the Possible Woman of the Year Award in 2007; and

19 WHEREAS, the citizens of Georgia owe a tremendous debt of gratitude to GLOW and 2010  
20 GLOW honoree Carol Hunstein for their many contributions to their communities and this  
21 state and the positive role models they represent for women of all ages.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
23 commend Georgia's Legacy; Older Women! for promoting generous volunteer service and  
24 selfless efforts to improve the quality of life within Georgia communities and extend  
25 congratulations to 2010 GLOW honoree Carol Hunstein.
