A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Georgia's Legacy; Older Women! (GLOW) and 2010 GLOW honoree Margery

20 GLOW honoree Margery Bouris for their many contributions to their communities and this
21 state and the positive role models they represent for women of all ages.
