12 former member of the Rotary Club and Jaycees Club; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Roberts is united in love and marriage to Suzanne Polk Roberts and was
14 blessed with four children, Anne Knox, Margie, Roy, Jr., and Marshall, and ten
15 grandchildren; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he remains active in sports, playing in competitive club tennis tournaments,
17 competing on a senior men's basketball team that placed third in the nation, and coaching
18 back-to-back championship teams at George Walton Academy; and
- 19 WHEREAS, his leadership and guidance have been instrumental as Chairman of the Walton
20 County Republican Party and he sponsors the largest political rally annually in the spring at
21 his farm; and
