## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Representative Rob Teilhet for his service to the Georgia House of  
2 Representatives; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Representative Teilhet planted his political seeds as an administrative aide to  
4 the Georgia State Senate in 1997; and

5 WHEREAS, Representative Teilhet earned both his undergraduate and law degrees from the  
6 University of Georgia in Athens where he also served as President of the Class of 2000; and

7 WHEREAS, Representative Rob Teilhet was elected in 2002 and has honorably served the  
8 people of the 40th district for eight years and has been the Chief Deputy Whip of the House
