A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the members of the Board of Directors of the Faith and Clergy
2 Commission; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the purpose of the Faith and Clergy Commission, Inc., is to express appreciation
4 and gratitude to members of the clergy and faith communities and conduct a gathering or
5 meeting at least once annually at the capitol during the session of the Georgia General
6 Assembly, along with any other state or federal legislative or political body; and

16 nonsectarian; and

17 WHEREAS, the commission provides it shall not by resolution or otherwise be committed
18 to the support or endorsement of any candidate for public office; and
