A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-5-30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 restricted licenses, so as to change provisions relating to suspension of a license when driving
- 3 on a restricted license; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Code Section 40-5-30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to restricted
- 7 licenses, is amended by revising subsection (c) and adding a new subsection to read as
- 8 follows:

- 9 "(c) The department, upon receiving satisfactory evidence of any violation of the
- 10 restrictions of such license, may suspend the license for a period of six months. The
- 11 department shall reinstate the license at the end of six months upon receipt of a
- reinstatement fee of \$210.00 or \$200.00 if paid by mail. No person shall operate a motor
- vehicle in any manner in violation of the restrictions imposed in a restricted license issued
- to him or her.
- 15 (d) Upon a person being convicted of a violation of this Code section, the court may order
- the department to suspend such person's license for a period not to exceed six months. The
- 17 court shall determine the length of such suspension and shall report such suspension and
- 18 <u>the length thereof to the department. The department shall reinstate the license at the end</u>
- of the suspension period upon receipt of a reinstatement fee of \$210.00 or \$200.00 if paid
- 20 by mail."

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
