A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To provide that the clerk of the Magistrate Court of Lumpkin County shall be appointed by
- 2 and serve at the pleasure of the chief magistrate; to provide for related matters; to provide a
- 3 contingent effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 The clerk of the Magistrate Court of Lumpkin County shall be appointed by and serve at the
- 7 pleasure of the chief magistrate.

8 SECTION 2.

- 9 This Act shall become effective only if there is enacted into law at the 2010 session of the
- 10 General Assembly a general law to provide that the General Assembly may at any time
- specify by local law who shall serve as clerk of magistrate court. If such a general law is so
- 12 enacted, this Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month
- as of which both such general law and this Act have been approved by the Governor or have
- 14 become law without such approval.

15 SECTION 3.

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
