8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a joint session of the House of Representatives and the
9 Senate be held in the hall of the House of Representatives at 9:45 A.M. on the aforesaid date

10 for the purpose of hearing an address from His Excellency, the Governor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a committee of fourteen, seven from the House to be named by the Speaker and seven from the Senate to be named by the President Pro Tempore, be appointed to escort His Excellency, the Governor, to the hall of the House of Representatives.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Justices of the Supreme Court and the Judges of the
Court of Appeals are hereby extended an invitation to be present at the joint session.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is hereby
instructed to transmit a copy of this resolution to the Governor, to each Justice of the
Supreme Court, and to each Judge of the Court of Appeals.
