A RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to authorize the General Assembly to provide by general law for the payment of rewards to the first person or firm or combination thereof which puts down and brings in the first commercial oil well in this state and to the first person or firm or combination thereof which puts down and brings in the first commercial natural gas well in this state; to provide for the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 The Constitution of Georgia is amended in Article III, Section VI, Paragraph VI by revising
10 subparagraph (b) as follows:

SECTION 1.

11 "(b)(1) All laws heretofore adopted under Article III, Section VIII, Paragraph XII of the 12 Constitution of 1976 in force and effect on June 30, 1983, shall continue in force and 13 effect and may be amended if such amendments are consistent with the authority granted 14 to the General Assembly by such provisions of said Constitution; provided, however, that 15 the provisions of subparagraph (3) of said provision of the Constitution of 1976 shall be 16 superseded by subparagraph (2) of this subparagraph.

17 (2) The General Assembly may provide by general law for the payment of rewards to 18 the first person or firm or combination thereof which puts down and brings in the first commercial oil well in this state and to the first person or firm or combination thereof 19 20 which puts down and brings in the first commercial natural gas well in this state. The 21 amount of any such rewards, the minimal amounts of daily production required to qualify 22 as commercial wells, and the authority for determining whether such wells are producing 23 such minimal amounts of daily production shall be as established by general law. Such 24 law shall provide for the distribution of the amount of the reward between the persons or firms which drill or cause to be drilled said wells and the contractors who furnish such 25 26 equipment, among such workers and employees actually engaged in the job, and to the

27	mineral, gas, or property owners where the wells are drilled. Said law shall provide for
28	the method of payments by the Governor."

29		SECTION 2.	
30	The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as		
31	provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the		
32	above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:		
33	"() YES	Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to authorize the General	
34		Assembly to provide by general law for the payment of rewards to the first	
35	() NO	person or firm or combination thereof which puts down and brings in the	
36		first commercial oil well in this state and to the first person or firm or	
37		combination thereof which puts down and brings in the first commercial	
38		natural gas well in this state?"	
39	All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."		
40	All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If		
41	such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall		

42 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
