A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-5-30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 restricted licenses, so as to change the penalty for violation of restrictions of a driver's
3 license; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

6 Code Section 40-5-30 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to restricted
7 licenses, is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:

8 "(c) The department, upon receiving satisfactory evidence of any violation of the
9 restrictions of such license, may ~~suspend the license for a period of six months~~ assess a
10 civil penalty not to exceed \$100.00 for the first offense, \$300.00 for the second offense,
11 and \$500.00 for the third and each subsequent offense. No person shall operate a motor
12 vehicle in any manner in violation of the restrictions imposed in a restricted license issued
13 to him or her."

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
