| 8 | safety belts in passenger vehicles, is amended by revising subsections (a) and (b) as follows: |
| 9 | "(a) As used in this Code section, the term 'passenger vehicle' means every motor vehicle |
| 10 | designed to carry ten passengers or less fewer and used for the transportation of persons |
| 11 | but shall not mean pickup trucks, motorcycles, motor driven cycles, or vehicles equipped |
| 12 | for off-road use, provided that the term 'passenger vehicle' includes any sport utility vehicle |
| 13 | and also includes pickup trucks for any occupant who is under 18 years of age. |
| 14 | (b) Each occupant of the front seat and rear seats of a passenger vehicle shall, while such |
| 15 | passenger vehicle is being operated on a public road, street, or highway of this state, be |
| 16 | restrained by a seat safety belt approved under Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 208. |
