A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 46-5-122 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 definitions relative to emergency telephone 9-1-1 systems, so as to redefine certain terms;  
3 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

6 Code Section 46-5-122 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions  
7 relative to emergency telephone 9-1-1 systems, is amended by revising paragraph (5) as  
8 follows:

9 "(5) 'Emergency 9-1-1 system' or '9-1-1 system' means a telephone service, computer  
10 service, wireless service, or other service which facilitates the placing of calls by persons  
11 in need of emergency services to a public safety answering point by dialing the telephone  
12 number 9-1-1 and under which calls to 9-1-1 are answered or otherwise responded to by  
13 public safety answering points established and operated by the local government  
14 subscribing to the 9-1-1 service. The term 'emergency 9-1-1 system' also includes  
15 'enhanced 9-1-1 service,' ~~which.~~

16 (5.1) 'Enhanced 9-1-1 service' means an emergency system that provides the user with  
17 emergency 9-1-1 system service and, in addition, directs 9-1-1 calls and may, as an  
18 adjunct to such service, direct non-emergency calls which relate to public safety agencies,  
19 to appropriate public safety answering points by selective routing based on the  
20 geographical location from which the call originated and provides the capability for  
21 automatic number identification and automatic location identification features."

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
