A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-3-519.5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 eligibility requirements for a HOPE grant at a branch of the Technical College System of
- 3 Georgia, so as to provide that students at Georgia Military College shall be eligible for HOPE
- 4 grants; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 20-3-519.5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to eligibility
- 8 requirements for a HOPE grant at a branch of the Technical College System of Georgia, is
- 9 amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 10 "(a) To be eligible for a HOPE grant, a student seeking a diploma or certificate at a branch
- of the Technical College System of Georgia, or a unit of the University System of Georgia,
- or at Georgia Military College shall:
- 13 (1) Meet residency requirements by meeting the requirements to be classified as a legal
- resident of Georgia as established by the program promulgated by the Georgia Student
- Finance Commission which shall be based upon the in-state tuition policy of the board
- of regents, and the in-state tuition guidelines set by the Technical College System of
- 17 Georgia, and the in-state tuition guidelines set by Georgia Military College; and
- 18 (2) Meet enrollment standards by being admitted, enrolled, and classified as an
- undergraduate student in a matriculated status in a program of study leading to a
- 20 certificate or diploma and maintaining satisfactory academic progress in accordance with
- 21 the standards and practices used for federal Title IV programs by the institution at which
- the student is enrolled."

23 SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
