A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 8 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 employment and training of peace officers, so as to require governmental entities to verify
- 3 that employees exercising the powers of arrest are certified; to provide for related matters;
- 4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 8 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to employment and
- 8 training of peace officers, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "35-8-27.
- No agency, department, authority, commission, or other governmental entity of this state
- or any subdivision of this state shall authorize an employee, contractor, or subcontractor
- 12 <u>to exercise the power of arrest, including the issuance of a traffic citation, without ensuring</u>
- 13 <u>that such employee, contractor, or subcontractor is certified in accordance with this chapter.</u>
- 14 Governmental entities shall routinely verify that all certified employees, contractors, and
- 15 <u>subcontractors authorized to exercise the power of arrest maintain a current and valid</u>
- 16 <u>certification.</u>"

17 SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
