## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mrs. Martha Jane Gunn Wilhoit; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Mrs. Martha Jane Gunn Wilhoit on December 29, 2008; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mrs. Wilhoit was the beloved daughter of Jamie Simeon Gunn and Blanche  
5 Lowe Gunn; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a native of Warren County, Georgia, Mrs. Wilhoit graduated from Georgia State  
7 College for Women in Milledgeville, Georgia, where she earned her Bachelor of Science  
8 degree in education; and
- 9 WHEREAS, this dedicated educator devoted her career to the public schools of Rockdale,  
10 Greene, Morgan, Washington, Hancock, Jefferson, and Warren Counties; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Mrs. Wilhoit retired from Briarwood Academy in 1992 after 18 years of  
12 service; and
- 13 WHEREAS, this remarkable Georgian was an active member of Johnson United Methodist  
14 Church, Sunday School Class, the Warren County Chamber of Commerce, and the Daughters  
15 of the American Revolution; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Wilhoit was united in love and marriage to Jud P. Wilhoit, and she is  
17 survived by her children, Judson "Trip" Wilhoit III and Ocie Blanche "O.B." Wilhoit  
18 McCorkle, two grandchildren, and many loyal friends; and
- 19 WHEREAS, all who were privileged to know this distinguished Georgian join her family in  
20 mourning her loss.
