# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

2	correct typographical, stylistic, and other errors and omissions in Title 21 of the Official
3	Code of Georgia Annotated and in Acts of the General Assembly amending Title 21 of the
4	Official Code of Georgia Annotated; to correct capitalization and spelling in Title 21 of the
5	Official Code of Georgia Annotated; to provide for necessary or appropriate revisions and
6	modernizations of matters contained in Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated;
7	to provide for other matters relating to Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated;
8	to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

#### **SECTION 1.**

11 Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elections, is amended in:

12 (1) Code Section 21-2-381, relating to making of application for absentee ballot,

determination of eligibility by ballot clerk, furnishing of applications to colleges and 13 14 universities, and persons entitled to make application, by replacing "registar" with "registrar"

15 in the last sentence of paragraph (4) of subsection (a).

(2) Code Section 21-5-70, relating to definitions in regard to public officials' conduct and 16

lobbyist disclosure, by replacing "vender" with "vendor" both times it appears in 17 18 subparagraph (G) of paragraph (5).

### **SECTION 2.**

20 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law 21 without such approval.
