A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dean Scott Angle of the University of Georgia's College of
2 Agricultural and Environmental Sciences; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the deans of the University of Georgia College of Agricultural and
4 Environmental Sciences have long been recognized as important leaders in Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, these champions of agriculture have preserved the land-grant mission of
6 teaching, researching, and extending knowledge for the last nine generations of Georgians;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, Dr. Scott Angle was selected as Dean and Director of the college on August 15,
9 2005, from a national pool of applicants; and

10 WHEREAS, a former Fulbright Scholar and a nationally recognized soil scientist, Dr. Angle
11 is the author of over 350 scientific papers in the field of soil microbiology and biochemistry;

13 WHEREAS, the Maryland native earned his bachelor's and master's degrees in soil
14 microbiology from the University of Maryland, his doctorate from the University of
15 Missouri, and during his distinguished career has been recognized as a fellow of the
16 American Society of Agronomy and the Soil Science Society of America; and

17 WHEREAS, under the leadership of Dean Angle, the College of Agricultural and
18 Environmental Sciences now exceeds all other colleges at the University of Georgia in
19 extramural funding; and

20 WHEREAS, Dean Angle's vision and passion for education has led to the College of
21 Agricultural and Environmental Sciences achieving the highest student enrollment ever in
22 2008; and

23 WHEREAS, *Georgia Trend* magazine annually evaluates the contributions of leaders in
24 business, government, and academia, highlighting a list of the 100 most influential
25 Georgians; and

26 WHEREAS, in just three short years, Dean Scott Angle has developed a reputation of
27 integrity, vision, and service which has earned him the honor and distinction of being named
28 as one of the 100 Most Influential Georgians.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
30 commend Dean Scott Angle for his contributions and achievements as Dean and Director of
31 the University of Georgia College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, and
32 congratulate him on his inclusion in Georgia Trend's 2009 list of 100 Most Influential
33 Georgians.
