

Senate Bill 102

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 35-3-34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 disclosure and dissemination of criminal records to private persons and businesses, resulting
3 responsibility and liability of issuing center, and provision of certain information to the FBI
4 in conjunction with the National Instant Criminal Background Check System, so as to
5 increase the fees for providing certain criminal records; to provide for related matters; to
6 provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 35-3-34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to disclosure and
10 dissemination of criminal records to private persons and businesses, resulting responsibility
11 and liability of issuing center, and provision of certain information to the FBI in conjunction
12 with the National Instant Criminal Background Check System, is amended by revising
13 subsection (d.3) as follows:

14 "(d.3) No fee charged pursuant to this Code section may exceed ~~\$20.00~~ \$40.00 per person
15 whose criminal history record is requested or be charged to any person or entity authorized
16 prior to January 1, 1995, to obtain information pursuant to this Code section without
17 payment of such fee."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
20 without such approval.

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
