A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 49-5-41 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 persons and agencies permitted access to records concerning reports of child abuse, so as to
3 authorize solicitors-general and assistant solicitors-general to have access to such reports for
4 official purposes; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 49-5-41 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to persons and
8 agencies permitted access to records concerning reports of child abuse, is amended by
9 revising paragraph (4) of subsection (a) as follows:

10 "(4) ~~A~~ The district attorney of any judicial circuit in this state, a solicitor-general, or any
11 assistant district attorney or assistant solicitor-general who may seek such access in
12 connection with official duty;"

13 **SECTION 2.**

14 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
