## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-5-263 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 qualifications, duties, and compensation of appraisers, so as to prohibit persons who are
- 3 serving or have served in the past year as a member of a county board of tax assessors from
- 4 serving as an employee of the board; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 48-5-263 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to qualifications,
- 9 duties, and compensation of appraisers, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 10 "(a) Qualifications.
- 11 (1) The commissioner shall establish, and the state merit system may review, the
- qualifications and rate of compensation for each appraiser grade.
- 13 (2) Each appraiser shall, before his <u>or her</u> employment, obtain a satisfactory grade, as
- determined by the commissioner, on an examination prepared by the commissioner and
- an institution of higher education in this state.
- 16 (3) No person who is serving on a county board of tax assessors or who has served on
- 17 <u>a county board of tax assessors within the preceding 12 month period shall be eligible to</u>
- serve as an employee of that board until the expiration of the 12 month period following
- such person's service as a member of the board."

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
