### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Miss Amanda Bennett; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Miss Amanda Bennett has been selected to represent Georgia on the National  
3 Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA) Youth Leadership Council (YLC); and
- 4 WHEREAS, a resident of Willacoochee, Georgia, Miss Bennett is a senior at Coffee County  
5 High School and the daughter of Billy and Tammy Bennett; and
- 6 WHEREAS, during her participation in the 2008 Washington Youth Tour as a Satilla REMC  
7 delegate, Miss Bennett was chosen by her peers to be Georgia's YLC representative; and
- 8 WHEREAS, when Miss Bennett returned to the National YLC Conference to represent  
9 Georgia in a week of leadership training, co-op education, and speech competitions, she was  
10 chosen from among 43 other students for the prestigious position as national spokesperson;

- 12 WHEREAS, this great honor places Miss Bennett among only two other Georgia national  
13 spokespersons; and
- 14 WHEREAS, as national spokesperson, Miss Bennett will give her winning speech at  
15 NRECA's 2009 annual meeting in New Orleans and will also speak to over 1,500 students  
16 while attending the 2009 tour; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this  
18 bright and promising young leader.

20 commend Miss Amanda Bennett on her remarkable achievements and extend to her sincere
