## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia to establish and offer a
- 2 teacher education program at each of its universities offering four-year degree programs; and
- 3 for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, each year in Georgia the demand grows for qualified teachers as the population
- 5 expands creating a shortage of teachers in all areas of education; and
- 6 WHEREAS, while the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia has encouraged
- 7 all institutions with teacher education programs to implement aggressive recruitment policies
- 8 to increase the number and raise the caliber and diversity of teacher candidates in order to
- 9 balance supply and demand, the teacher shortage in Georgia continues to grow; and
- 10 WHEREAS, increasing the number of teacher education programs at universities across this
- state would reduce the shortage of educators in these areas and significantly increase the
- 12 number of qualified and available teachers in Georgia; and
- 13 WHEREAS, it is recommended that teacher education programs across the state be expanded
- 14 and established.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body urges the Board
- of Regents of the University System of Georgia to establish and offer a teacher education
- 17 program at each of its universities offering four-year degree programs.
