A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Charlie Brown; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Charlie Brown is a longstanding and dedicated member of the Boy Scouts of
3 America, and this outstanding scout has successfully met all requirements for the Eagle Scout
4 Award, which will be bestowed upon him at an Eagle Scout Court of Honor Ceremony; and
- 5 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest
6 achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only about 1 in every 100 of all Boy Scouts earn the rank of Eagle Scout; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a Scout has developed leadership
9 abilities, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
10 of immense benefit to himself and others throughout his life; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in order for a Scout to reach this goal, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of
12 which are mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, for his final accomplishment to achieve his ranking, Charlie Brown made
14 beautiful landscaping enhancements to an entrance of Hillcrest Baptist Church in Acworth,
15 Georgia; and
- 16 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Charlie Brown has brought honor to himself,
17 his family, his troop, and his community.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 Charlie Brown is recognized and commended on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and he is
20 extended the best wishes of each member of this body for success and happiness in future
21 endeavors.
