A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 4 of Chapter 7 of Title 46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to penalties relative to motor carriers, so as to provide that every motor carrier
- 3 subject to regulation by the Public Service Commission shall be provided information
- 4 emphasizing that it is illegal to allow persons under the age of 21 to possess or consume
- 5 alcoholic beverages while being transported; to provide for penalties; to provide for related
- 6 matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 4 of Chapter 7 of Title 46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 penalties relative to motor carriers, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 "<u>46-7-92.</u>
- Any carrier subject to the jurisdiction of the commission that transports passengers shall
- comply with the provisions of paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of Code Section 3-3-23,
- concerning consumption of alcoholic beverages by persons under the age of 21. The
- commission shall provide to all carriers under its jurisdiction that transport passengers, at
- 17 <u>the time of registration or renewal of a certificate, an informational packet emphasizing the</u>
- prohibition on alcohol consumption by persons under the age of 21 while being transported
- by the carrier."
- SECTION 2.
- 21 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 22 without such approval.
- SECTION 3.
- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
