- 2 WHEREAS, for more than 30 years, Dr. C.L. Anderson served as Moderator of the Tattnall
3 Missionary Baptist Association in Hagan, Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, under Dr. Anderson's leadership, numerous programs were established and
5 various churches joined the Association's ranks; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Dr. Anderson served the Tattnall Association with integrity, displaying an
7 uncanny leadership that resulted in the Tattnall Association developing a reputation as one
8 of the most respected Associations in the General Missionary Baptist Convention of Georgia;

- 10 WHEREAS, Dr. Anderson was selected as a Vice Moderator for the General Missionary
11 Baptist Convention and serves as the Convention's liaison for its moderators' division to the
12 National Baptist Convention; and

14 September of 2008 and was bestowed with the title of Moderator Emeritus the following
15 December.
