## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Mr. Samuel A. Lyons for his induction into the Georgia Aviation Hall of
- 2 Fame; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, inspired by his father who was a pilot in World War II, Mr. Samuel A. Lyons's
- 4 love for aviation began at an early age; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a native of Atlanta, Georgia, Mr. Lyons earned his pilot's license while
- 6 attending school at Presbyterian College; and
- 7 WHEREAS, after completing his college education, Mr. Lyons served for two years in the
- 8 United States Army and then returned home to open a hobby shop, Historical Hobbies; and
- 9 WHEREAS, during his years at Historical Hobbies, Mr. Lyons created fascinating and
- 10 hauntingly realistic paintings of a wide range of aircraft often mistaken for photographs,
- which have inspired pilots and aviation fans of all ages; and
- 12 WHEREAS, his painting *Lead Solo* graces the Air Force Art Hall in the United States
- 13 Pentagon with many others located in such prestigious locations as the Blue Angel
- 14 Headquarters, the Smithsonian Air and Space Museum, the Air Force Museum, and the
- 15 Royal Air Force Museum; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Mr. Lyons's paintings have been featured on many covers of books, magazines,
- and catalogs, including the children's book *What's a Piper Cub* that inspires countless young
- 18 future pilots; and
- 19 WHEREAS, long recognized for his artistic merit, Mr. Lyons received first place in the
- 20 General Aviation categories of the Aviation Week and Space Technology magazine's Best of
- 21 the Best 2003 Aviation Aerospace Art awards; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Lyons is one of the few civilians who have flown in the F-15 Eagle, the

- 23 F-16 Falcon, and in the F-18 Hornet with the United States Navy's Blue Angels; and
- 24 WHEREAS, passionate about all things aeronautical, Mr. Lyons is an active member of the
- 25 American Society of Aviation Artists, the Air Force Art Program, the Experimental Aircraft
- 26 Association, the Vintage Aircraft Association, Warbirds of America, and the 8th Air Force
- 27 Historical Society; and
- 28 WHEREAS, on February 14, 2009, Mr. Lyons will be formally inducted into the Georgia
- 29 Aviation Hall of Fame in a ceremony at the Robins Air Force Base Museum of Aviation; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Mr. Lyons is rightfully deserving of admission into the Georgia Aviation Hall
- 31 of Fame for his many achievements and the inspiration he has provided so many, and it is
- 32 both fitting and proper that we recognize this great pilot's contribution to Georgia's aviation
- 33 history.
- 34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 35 this body commends Mr. Sam Lyons for his induction into the Georgia Aviation Hall of
