A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Paul Winton Bohn; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Paul Winton Bohn has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished
3 rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and Paul
8 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught
9 through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a dedicated member of Troop 50, and to obtain
11 his rank as Eagle Scout, Paul worked with the Cobb County Cemetery Preservation
12 Commission to help restore Antioch Cemetery by building benches, repairing steps, cutting
13 down trees, raking leaves, cleaning grave markers, and trimming bushes; and
- 14 WHEREAS, this outstanding Georgian has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
15 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
16 becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
18 set an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 commend Paul Winton Bohn for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor
21 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious
22 rank of Eagle Scout.
