

House Bill 486

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 5 of Chapter 14 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to retirement benefits, disability benefits, and spouses' benefits under the Superior
3 Court Clerks' Retirement Fund of Georgia, so as to provide that persons who become
4 members on or after July 1, 2010, shall not be entitled to credit for service as a deputy clerk;
5 to provide for a death benefit; to provide conditions for an effective date and automatic
6 repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Article 5 of Chapter 14 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
10 retirement benefits, disability benefits, and spouses' benefits under the Superior Court Clerks'
11 Retirement Fund of Georgia, is amended by revising Code Section 47-14-77, relating to
12 service for which no credit may be received for retirement purposes, by adding a new
13 subsection to read as follows:

14 "(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter to the contrary, a clerk who first
15 or again becomes a member of this retirement fund on or after July 1, 2010, shall not be
16 entitled to receive credit for any purpose for prior service as a deputy clerk."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 Said article is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

19 "47-14-79.

20 A death benefit in the amount of \$5,000.00 shall be paid to the designated beneficiary of
21 any member who dies in service. In the absence of a designated beneficiary, such amount
22 shall be paid the deceased member's estate. For members eligible for a surviving spouse's
23 benefit, such amount shall be in addition to the benefit provided pursuant to Code Section
24 47-14-72."

SECTION 3.

26 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2010, only if it is determined to have been
27 concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia
28 Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not
29 become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2010, as
30 required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.

SECTION 4.

32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
