## A RESOLUTION

14 she was blessed with five remarkable and devoted children, Mark, Ralph, Phillip, Clinton,  
15 and Marsha; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated provided the  
17 foundation and framework of success in which all of her family members have developed  
18 and flourished; and
- 19 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
20 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,  
21 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

22 WHEREAS, she leaves behind family, neighbors, and loyal friends who will cherish her  
23 memory and the wonderful times shared.
