#### A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Lamar Mobley; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia and the entire Burke County community mourn the loss  
3 of one of its finest and most distinguished citizens with the untimely passing of Mr. Lamar  
4 Mobley; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Mobley traveled throughout the country attending trials on behalf of the  
6 Georgia Field Trial Association and served as a proud ambassador for Burke County; and

7 WHEREAS, a native and life-long resident of Burke County, Mr. Mobley owned a local  
8 cafeteria with his sister and Quality Dry Cleaners with his wife; and

9 WHEREAS, a kindhearted man known for his generosity, jovial nature, and love of field  
10 trials, Mr. Mobley served as the vice president for the Georgia Field Trial Association and  
11 devoted many years to assisting the organization in attracting visitors to the county; and

12 WHEREAS, a true animal lover, Mr. Mobley showed horses and dogs across the nation and  
13 was an important member of the National Bird Dog Foundation, convincing *The True Citizen*  
14 to carry a bird dog on its flag denoting Waynesboro as the Bird Dog Capital of the world; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Mobley and his wife were honored by the Burke County Chamber of  
16 Commerce as Citizens of the Year for 1993 for their contributions to the community and  
17 fellow citizens; and

18 WHEREAS, this distinguished Georgian gave inspiration to many through his high ideals,  
19 morals, and deep concern for his fellow citizens and he possessed the vast wisdom which  
20 only comes through experience and the strength of character which is achieved through  
21 overcoming the many challenges of life; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Mobley was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable  
23 reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of  
24 his life, he made this world a better place in which to live.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
26 join in honoring the life and memory of Mr. Lamar Mobley.
