A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to game and fish, so
- 2 as to define a term; to change certain provisions relating to taking of nongame species; to
- 3 regulate the taking, possession, transportation, farming, and selling of fresh-water turtles; to
- 4 provide for rules and regulations; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Title 27 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to game and fish, is amended by
- 8 adding a new paragraph in Code Section 27-1-2, relating to definitions, to read as follows:
- 9 "(29.2) 'Fresh-water turtle' means any turtle or its eggs within the families Chelydridae,
- 10 Emydidae (excluding Malaclemys terrapin and Terrapene carolina), Kinosternidae, and
- 11 <u>Trionychidae.</u>"
- 12 SECTION 2.
- 13 Said title is further amended by revising subsection (a) of Code Section 27-1-28, relating to
- 14 taking of nongame species, as follows:
- 15 "(a) Except as otherwise provided by law, rule, or regulation, it shall be unlawful to hunt,
- trap, fish, take, possess, or transport any nongame species of wildlife, except that the
- following species may be taken by any method except those specifically prohibited by law
- or regulation:
- 19 (1) Rats;
- 20 (2) Mice;
- 21 (3) Coyotes;
- 22 (4) Armadillos;
- 23 (5) Groundhogs;
- 24 (6) Beaver;
- 25 (7) Fresh-water turtles Reserved;

- 26 (8) Poisonous snakes;
- 27 (9) Frogs;
- 28 (10) Spring lizards;
- 29 (11) Fiddler crabs;
- 30 (12) Fresh-water crayfish;
- 31 (13) Fresh-water mussels; and
- 32 (14) Nutria."
- 33 SECTION 3.
- 34 Said title is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 35 "27-3-19.1.
- 36 (a) It shall be unlawful to take any fresh-water turtle other than as authorized by rules and
- 37 <u>regulations of the board, except that fresh-water turtles may be taken from private ponds</u>
- with the landowner's permission.
- 39 (b) It shall be unlawful to possess, transport, farm, or sell any fresh-water turtle or part
- 40 thereof except in accordance with rules and regulations adopted by the board.
- 41 (c) As the board deems appropriate for purposes of this Code section, it may promulgate
- 42 <u>such rules and regulations as are reasonable and necessary under sound wildlife</u>
- 43 <u>management practices."</u>
- 44 SECTION 4.
- 45 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
