AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 16 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to death investigations by coroners, so as to provide for the training of canine service
- 3 dogs for the purpose of body recovery and rescue of persons; to provide for related matters;
- 4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 16 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 death investigations by coroners, is revised by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "45-16-50.
- A medical examiner within the state of Georgia is authorized to provide to an approved
- canine instructor or school certain biological substances such as human blood or bodily
- 12 <u>fluids for the sole purpose of utilizing such substances for the training and handling of</u>
- police canine in body recovery of human remains or rescue of persons. Such biological
- substances shall be contained and transported in accordance with appropriate health and
- 15 <u>safety standards.</u>"

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
