## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-2-2068.2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 a facilities fund for charter schools, so as to revise certain provisions relating to the use of
- 3 surplus property of a local board of education by a local charter school; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 20-2-2068.2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to a facilities
- 8 fund for charter schools, is amended by revising subsection (h) as follows:
- 9 "(h) Each local board of education that has designated owns any facility or property as or
- portion thereof that is designated as surplus, intended for disposal, or otherwise unused by
- 11 <u>students</u> shall make such facility or property <u>or portion thereof</u> available <del>for lease or</del>
- 12 purchase by to a local charter school on the same basis as it makes such facility or property
- available to other public schools under the control and management of the local board of
- education. A conversion <u>local</u> charter school may not be charged a rental or leasing fee for
- 15 the existing facility or for property normally used by the public school which became the
- 16 conversion charter school. A local charter school that receives property from a local board
- may not sell or dispose of such property without the written permission of the local board."

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
