BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 An Act providing a supplemental salary for the judges of the Superior Court of the Coweta
- 10 Judicial Circuit, approved December 11, 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, Nov.-Dec. Sess., p. 92), as
- amended, particularly by an Act approved April 2, 1998 (Ga. L. 1998, p. 4254), is amended
- 12 by revising subsection (a) of Section 2 to read as follows:

13 "SECTION 2

- 14 (a) The board of commissioners or other governing authority for the counties of Carroll,
- 15 Coweta, Heard, Meriwether, and Troup shall supplement the salaries of each of the judges
- of the Superior Court of the Coweta Judicial Circuit in the following amounts: Carroll
- 17 County shall pay the sum of \$10,134.00 per annum per judge; Coweta County shall pay the
- sum of \$7,599.00 per annum per judge; Heard County shall pay the sum of \$1,233.00 per
- annum per judge; Meriwether County shall pay the sum of \$3,168.00 per annum per judge;
- Troup County shall pay the sum of \$7,866.00 per annum per judge."

SECTION 2.

- 23 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 24 without such approval.
