A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Georgia State Patrol Trooper Tony M. Lumley and dedicating a highway
2 in his memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the law enforcement community and the State of Georgia lost one of their finest
4 husbands, fathers, and law enforcement officers when Georgia State Patrol Trooper Tony M.
5 Lumley gave his life in defense of the public on December 2, 2003; and

6 WHEREAS, Trooper Lumley joined the Georgia State Patrol as a Trooper Cadet in March,
7 2002, and completed his training at the 79th Georgia State Patrol Trooper School and
8 graduated as one of the school's most bright and promising troopers in October of that year;

10 WHEREAS, he was assigned to the State Patrol post in Forest Park, Georgia, and, as a result
11 of his outstanding performance and work ethic, he was transferred to the State Patrol post in
12 Griffin, Georgia, in February, 2003; and

13 WHEREAS, a consummate team player, he was admired and respected by his peers for his
14 mastery of law enforcement and public relations skills, sense of humor, and professional
15 attitude; and

16 WHEREAS, he was an exemplary law enforcement officer who was held in high esteem for
17 his disciplined and faithful devotion to protecting and preserving the public's safety; and

18 WHEREAS, Trooper Lumley is survived by his loving and devoted wife, Misty, and his
19 precious daughters, Nikki and Brook.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 GEORGIA that the members of this body express their sincerest condolences to the family
22 and friends of Trooper Tony M. Lumley upon his passing.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the portion SR 18 in Pike County, Georgia, be dedicated
24 as the Trooper Tony M. Lumley Memorial Highway.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
26 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Trooper Tony M. Lumley
27 Memorial Highway.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
29 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the family of Trooper Tony
30 M. Lumley and the Department of Transportation.
