14 wisdom which only comes through experience and the strength of character which is
15 achieved through overcoming the many challenges of life; and

16 WHEREAS, known for her great skill in the kitchen, Ms. Rakestraw leaves behind her loving
17 children and their families, as well as a host of grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and
