A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 40-6-40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to when vehicles shall be driven of the right side of the highway, so as to provide that on certain highways all vehicles shall be driven on the right side of the roadway subject to certain exceptions; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Code Section 40-6-40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to when vehicles shall be driven of the right side of the highway, is amended by adding a new subsection to 9 read as follows: 10 11 "(e) Upon any roadway having two or more lanes for traffic moving in the same direction, 12 all vehicles shall be driven in the right-hand lanes when available for traffic except when 13 any of the following conditions exist: 14 (1) When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction; 15 (2) When traveling at a speed greater than the traffic flow; (3) When moving left to allow traffic to merge; or 16 17 (4) When preparing for a left turn at an intersection, exit, or into a private road or 18 driveway when such left turn is legally permitted." 19 **SECTION 2.** 20 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2009. 21 **SECTION 3.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
