A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Solomon Lodge No.1 of Free and Accepted Masons of
2 Georgia on the occasion of its 275th anniversary; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Solomon Lodge No.1 of Free and Accepted Masons of Georgia is the oldest
4 continuously operated English constituted lodge of freemasons in the Western Hemisphere
5 and will be celebrating its 275th anniversary this year in Savannah, Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, the brothers of the Solomon Lodge in Savannah are a Masonic fraternity
7 dedicated to the spirit of love of liberty, free thought, free speech, and free conscience; and

8 WHEREAS, precision and punctuality mark the history and tradition of the Solomon Lodge;
9 the Savannah chapter's history dates back to the 1730's and the earliest beginnings of the
10 Premier Grand Lodge of England; and

11 WHEREAS, the Lodge members have practiced the tenets of Free Masonry for many years
12 and have made outstanding community contributions to the Savannah area and the State of
13 Georgia; and

14 WHEREAS, in the spirit of helpfulness and brotherly love and guided by strict moral
15 principles, the Solomon Lodge seeks to encourage good will toward all mankind, and its
16 rituals are designed to dramatize a philosophy of life based on morality; and

17 WHEREAS, its members are dedicated to practicing in their daily lives the principles of
18 brotherly love, charity, and truth, and the benefits of their dedication inure to the benefit of
19 the entire state; and

20 WHEREAS, the lodge has kindled within its ranks that very precious spirit of giving that is
21 vital to maintaining a strong volunteer culture in local neighborhoods and communities, and
22 its magnanimous efforts inspire us all to engage ourselves in this proud American tradition.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 honor and commend the Solomon Lodge No.1 of Free and Accepted Masons of Georgia for
25 their magnificent contributions to the State of Georgia and congratulate its members on the
26 lodge's 275th anniversary.
