

House Bill 664

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 36-44-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 computation of tax allocation increments of tax allocation districts under the "Redevelopment
3 Powers Law," so as to provide that the administrative body of a community improvement
4 district may consent to the inclusion of taxes levied by it in the computation of tax allocation
5 increments; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal
6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 36-44-9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to computation of
10 tax allocation increments of tax allocation districts under the "Redevelopment Powers Law,"
11 is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

12 "(b.1) When a tax allocation district is created within the area of operation of a community
13 improvement district, as established by Article IX, Section VII of the Georgia Constitution,
14 by the local legislative body of the municipality or the local legislative body of the county,
15 all or part of the ad valorem property taxes levied by the community improvement district
16 may be included in the computation of tax allocation increments of a municipal tax
17 allocation district or county tax allocation district if the administrative body of the
18 community improvement district finds that such inclusion is consistent with the
19 constitutional purpose of such taxes and consents to such inclusion by resolution duly
20 adopted by said administrative body."

21 **SECTION 2.**

22 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
23 without such approval.

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SECTION 3.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
