9 WHEREAS, Glenn played baseball and basketball and was active in the youth group at  
10 Pleasant Valley South Baptist Church; and

11 WHEREAS, he leaves behind his parents, David and Laura; his sister, LeeAnn; and his  
12 grandparents, Johnny and Sarah Smith and Eunice Smith.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 GEORGIA that the members of this body celebrate the much too short life of Glenn  
15 McCarver Smith III and dedicate the bridge over Big Cedar Creek near Cave Spring on US  
16 411/SR 53 as the Glenn McCarver Smith III Memorial Bridge.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
18 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Glenn McCarver Smith III  
19 Memorial Bridge.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
21 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the Department of  
22 Transportation and to the family of Glenn McCarver Smith III.
