A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Douglas Carlisle King; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Douglas Carlisle King has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most
3 distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
8 Douglas has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special
9 skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, to obtain his rank as Eagle Scout, this dedicated young man designed and
11 constructed an outdoor worship center at Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church, a project in
12 which he built a stage and four rows of seating and coordinated 52 volunteers performing
13 over 416 hours of work; and
- 14 WHEREAS, this outstanding member of Troop 580 has truly exhibited a commitment to the
15 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
16 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
18 sets an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 commend Douglas Carlisle King for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest
21 honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
22 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
