## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Ms. Judy Patricia Colbert Heath on the occasion of her  
2 retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Ms. Judy Patricia Colbert Heath has long been recognized by the citizens of  
4 this state for the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal  
5 commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,  
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced  
8 dramatically by her 34 years of superlative service to at risk youth and their families; and

10 Georgia, and holds an associate's degree in criminal justice and a bachelor's degree in

18 WHEREAS, she has specialized training in the areas of sex offender treatment, family  
19 counseling, and group dynamics; and

20 WHEREAS, Ms. Heath serves as an example to her community with her involvement on the  
21 boards for Augusta/Richmond County, MH/MR/SA Services, the Department of Family and  
22 Children Services, and Richmond County Transition Services; and

23 WHEREAS, she is a member of the Augusta Coalition for Children and Youth, the Georgia  
24 Juvenile Services Association, the American Correction Association, the Augusta Chapter  
25 for The Links, Inc., and the Zodiettes Social Club; and

26 WHEREAS, her significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable patience  
27 and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of  
28 this state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

29 WHEREAS, Ms. Heath plans to enjoy her well-deserved retirement with her loving husband  
30 Richard Heath, Jr., and her two children, Richard and Kimberly; and

31 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
