## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 49-5-41 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 1 persons and agencies permitted access to records concerning reports of child abuse, so as to 2 authorize solicitors-general and assistant solicitors-general to have access to such reports for 3 official purposes; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other 4 purposes. 5

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7	SECTION 1.
8	Code Section 49-5-41 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to persons and
9	agencies permitted access to records concerning reports of child abuse, is amended by
10	revising paragraph (4) of subsection (a) as follows:
11	"(4) A <u>The</u> district attorney of any judicial circuit in this state, a solicitor-general, or any
12	assistant district attorney or assistant solicitor-general who may seek such access in
13	connection with official duty;"
14	<b>SECTION 2.</b>
15	This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
16	without such approval.
