A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 43-11-46.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 continuing education requirement and waiver, so as to provide waiver of certain continuing
- 3 education hours; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 4 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 43-11-46.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to continuing
- 8 education requirement and waiver, is amended by revising said Code section as follows:
- 9 "43-11-46.1.
- 10 (a) The board shall be authorized to require persons seeking renewal of a dental license
- under this chapter to complete board approved continuing education of not less than 40
- hours biennially. The board shall be authorized to approve courses offered by institutions
- of higher learning, specialty societies, or professional organizations and to designate the
- number of hours required and the category in which those hours should be earned.
- 15 (b) The board shall be authorized to waive the continuing education requirement in cases
- of hardship, disability, or illness or under such other circumstances as the board deems
- 17 appropriate.
- 18 (c) The board shall be authorized to waive five hours of continuing education requirements
- 19 <u>for persons who have completed 20 hours of volunteer practice for public agencies or</u>
- 20 <u>institutions, not for profit agencies, not for profit institutions, nonprofit corporations, or not</u>
- 21 <u>for profit associations which provide dentistry services only to indigent patients as</u>
- determined by the board for approval of such waiver.
- 23 (c)(d) The board shall be authorized to promulgate rules and regulations to implement and
- 24 ensure compliance with the requirements of this Code section.
- 25 (d)(e) This Code section shall apply to each licensing, certification, and renewal cycle
- 26 which begins after the 1990-1991 renewal. <u>Subsection (c) of this Code section shall apply</u>

27 to each licensing, certification, and renewal cycle which begins after the 2008-2009
