- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Eli Robert "E.R." Bates, Jr.; and for other purposes.

3 with the passing of Mr. Eli Robert "E.R." Bates, Jr., on October 28, 2008; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Bates was born in Atlanta, Georgia, a beloved son of the late Robert Bates,
5 Sr., and Lois Hilderbrand Bates; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty during World War
7 II, and upon his return home he took over his father's business, Bates Hardware Company,
8 where he worked until his retirement in 1973; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Bates was active in his trade, belonging to associations such as the Atlanta
10 Retail Hardware Association and the National Retail Hardware Association, and served as
11 president of the Northside Business Association and the Georgia-Florida Retail Hardware
12 Association; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in honor of his 50 years of dedicated service to the hardware industry, Mr. Bates
14 was awarded the prestigious Gold Hammer; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was devoted to his community and served as a civic leader as a member of
16 the Cartersville Chamber of Commerce, the Mason Lodge, the Yaraab Shrine Temple, and
17 the Elks Lodge #1969; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Mr. Bates was united in love and marriage for 59 years to his lovely wife
19 Wynell Hogeland Bates, and he was surrounded by the love of his daughter and son-in-law,
20 Linda and Chuck Walker; his adoring grandchildren, Tony, Kristy, and Christopher; and his
21 delightful great-granddaughters, Kayla and Ashlyn; and

22 WHEREAS, the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated provided the
23 foundation and framework of success in which all of his family members have developed and
24 flourished; and

25 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Bates will long be remembered for his
26 love of family and friendship, and this loyal husband, father, neighbor, and friend will be
27 missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
