Senators Shafer of the 48th and Hawkins of the 49th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Regulated Industries and Utilities Committee substitute to SB 82 (LC 36*
 2 *1387ERS) by inserting after "cases;" on line 7 the following:*
 3 *to exempt computers and computer equipment;*

4 *By inserting between lines 95 and 96 the following:*

SECTION 2A.

 6 Said article is further amended by revising Code Section 10-1-355, relating to purchases of
 7 regulated metal property exempted from application of article, as follows:

8 "10-1-355.

9 (a) This article shall not apply to purchases of regulated metal property from:

- 10 (1) Organizations, corporations, or associations registered with the state as charitable,
 11 philanthropic, religious, fraternal, civic, patriotic, social, or school-sponsored
 12 organizations or associations or from any nonprofit corporations or associations;
 13 (2) A law enforcement officer acting in an official capacity;
 14 (3) A trustee in bankruptcy, executor, administrator, or receiver who has presented proof
 15 of such status to the secondary metals recycler;
 16 (4) Any public official acting under judicial process or authority who has presented proof
 17 of such status to the secondary metals recycler;
 18 (5) A sale on the execution, or by virtue, of any process issued by a court if proof thereof
 19 has been presented to the secondary metals recycler; or
 20 (6) A manufacturing, industrial, or other commercial vendor that generates or sells
 21 regulated metal property in the ordinary course of its business.

22 (b) This article shall not apply to purchases of computers or computer equipment."
