WHEREAS, students who attend Georgia Virtual Academy are required to pass the same
state achievement tests as those attending public schools and are instructed by state
accredited teachers; and

- WHEREAS, Georgia Virtual Academy offers parents the option of personalized learning
 opportunities for their children, customized to meet each child's needs and tailored to their
 particular learning style and strengths; and
- WHEREAS, the outstanding education provided by Georgia Virtual Academy is worthy ofrecognition.
