## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Johnny James McGlamery; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Mr. Johnny James McGlamery on January 21, 2009; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. McGlamery was born in Bulloch County, Georgia, a beloved son of the late  
5 Claude B. and Bertha Stringer McGlamery; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United  
7 States Army and was a graduate of Georgia Southern College and the FBI National  
8 Academy; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. McGlamery valiantly and bravely protected his community and neighbors  
10 as a Georgia State Trooper for ten years and retired from his position as an inspector with the  
11 Georgia Bureau of Investigation after 20 years of dedicated service; and

13 and was blessed with the love of three children, Johnna, Kirk, and Brian, and nine  
14 grandchildren; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
16 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he  
17 made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 18 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. McGlamery will long be remembered  
19 for his love of fishing, family, and friendship, and this loyal husband, father, neighbor, and  
20 friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
