A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Dr. Jesse Bradley; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Dr. Jesse Bradley is widely recognized throughout the state as the
3 personification of excellence in education; and
- 4 WHEREAS, this highly respected professional educator and administrator has served with
5 honor and distinction as teacher, assistant principal, principal, and superintendent in the
6 Tattnall County School System for many years, and since 1997 as superintendent of the
7 Griffin-Spalding County School System; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he believes that his continuing role as school superintendent is to act as an
9 instrument of inspiration and enthusiasm to his pupils and to create a positive learning
10 environment through the encouragement of competitive instincts in students; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he has announced his retirement on May 31, 2009; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he is a shining example of the important impact that the efforts of individual
13 education professionals and school superintendents are making on the quality of education
14 received by the children of this state and it is abundantly fitting and proper that his
15 superlative accomplishments be recognized appropriately.
